## 2013 Paso Robles Cabernet Franc

### The Vintage

The 2013 growing season was one without heat or cool spikes. This Cabernet Franc from the West Side Ranch didn't believe in being average. It held on until November. The fruit of this vintage is known for good ripeness with intense flavors and balance.

### The Vineyard

West Side Ranch is located on Chimney Rock Road adjacent to the Adelaida School House. Warm, sunny days and cool evening temperatures create ideal conditions for intense aroma, flavor, and acidity development in the ripening grapes.

### The Winemaking Process

Blend: 85% Cabernet Franc 15% Petite Sirah

Harvest: November 5, 2013

pH: 3.9 Brix: 25.3

TA: 0.4g/ml Alcohol: 14.2%

Bottled: August 17, 2015

Aged in French oak barrels for 2 years.

### Tasting Notes

This confident and unabashed wine pours the color of blackberry jam as aromas of currant, plum and brown spices rise from the glass. The flavors of black cherry, blackberry and dark chocolate tempt you with a promise of fulfillment, as this medium weight wine leads to a long finish with well-integrated tannins. We recommend you enjoy it with heartier dishes such as pasta bolognese or Osso Bucco.
