The Vintage

The 2021 growing season was highlighted by a cold, dry winter. The majority of rain came in one storm. Colder temperatures arriving later than normal led to smaller clusters with incredible intensity. Although there were reduced yields, the payoff of flavor in the berries was a huge payoff. There was idyllic temperatures just prior to harvest, with cooler temperatures than normal allowing the grapes to take their time to reach full ripeness.

The Vineyards

Tempranillo fruit is from Jackie's vineyard located Arbor Rd. in the Templeton Gap AVA and the Grenache was harvested from Hoyt Family Vineyard in Willow Creek AVA. Both vineyard sites are located on the West Side of Paso Robles.

Minimal skin contact and direct to press. Gentle fining in juice stage during cold settling. Racked to Stainless and fermented between 58 - 62 F.

Tasting Notes

Our 2021 dry rose has a luxurious pale salmon color. Pouring this wine reveals aromas of white floral, fresh picked strawberry and Bing cherry. Your palate will experience peach, watermelon and perfectly picked red cherries. The lively acidity will have you craving another sip. This light bodied rose captures warm sunshine in your glass, and we guarantee it will make you smile.
